

Should you need to cancel / amend your place on an excursion more than 72 hours before travel, a fee of £5 per person per excursion will apply. If the excursion(s) include admission fees, these may also be payable. If you need to cancel / amend less than 72 hours before travel then a 100% cancellation charge will apply.

All day excursions need a minimum number of passengers to operate. Wherever practically possible we will run all our excursions as advertised, however we reserve the right to cancel excursions should the numbers be too low.

Children are, unless otherwise stated, classed as being between the ages of 3 to 15 years old on the day of the excursion. Passengers over the age of 15 must, unless otherwise stated, pay the adult fare.
